## TALAVERA PLATTER



### MATERIALS

- Bisque: Talavera Platter DB40067
  - Paints: 46, 98, 64, 2, 8, French Dimensions FD254 (Black Licorice)
    - Sponge
    - Small Round Brush
    - Small Flat Brush
      - Fan Brush
      - Thin Stick

### TIPS

- For best results, please read all instructions before beginning project.
- Refer to photo for color and design placement.
- Paint designs in first, dry, then outline with French Dimensions

## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Wipe plate with damp sponge to remove bisque dust.
2. Use small brushes to apply three coats of the following inside the shapes created with indented lines:
  - Yellow # 46 in center of flower and small leaves in large outer leaves.
  - Red # 98 in center flower petals and small circles in leaves and border design.
  - Light Blue # 64 around central flower, alternate squares in trims around the flower and outer rim.
  - Green # 8 in leaves surrounding the central flower.
  - Dark Blue # 2 in remaining small squares around flower and rim and unpainted area around leaves. Let dry.
3. Brush three coats of Dark Blue # 2 on the back of platter using . Let dry.
4. Remove tip from French Dimensions and stir paint with thin stick for even consistency. Place the tip back on the bottle and squeeze paint over the incised lines on plate.
